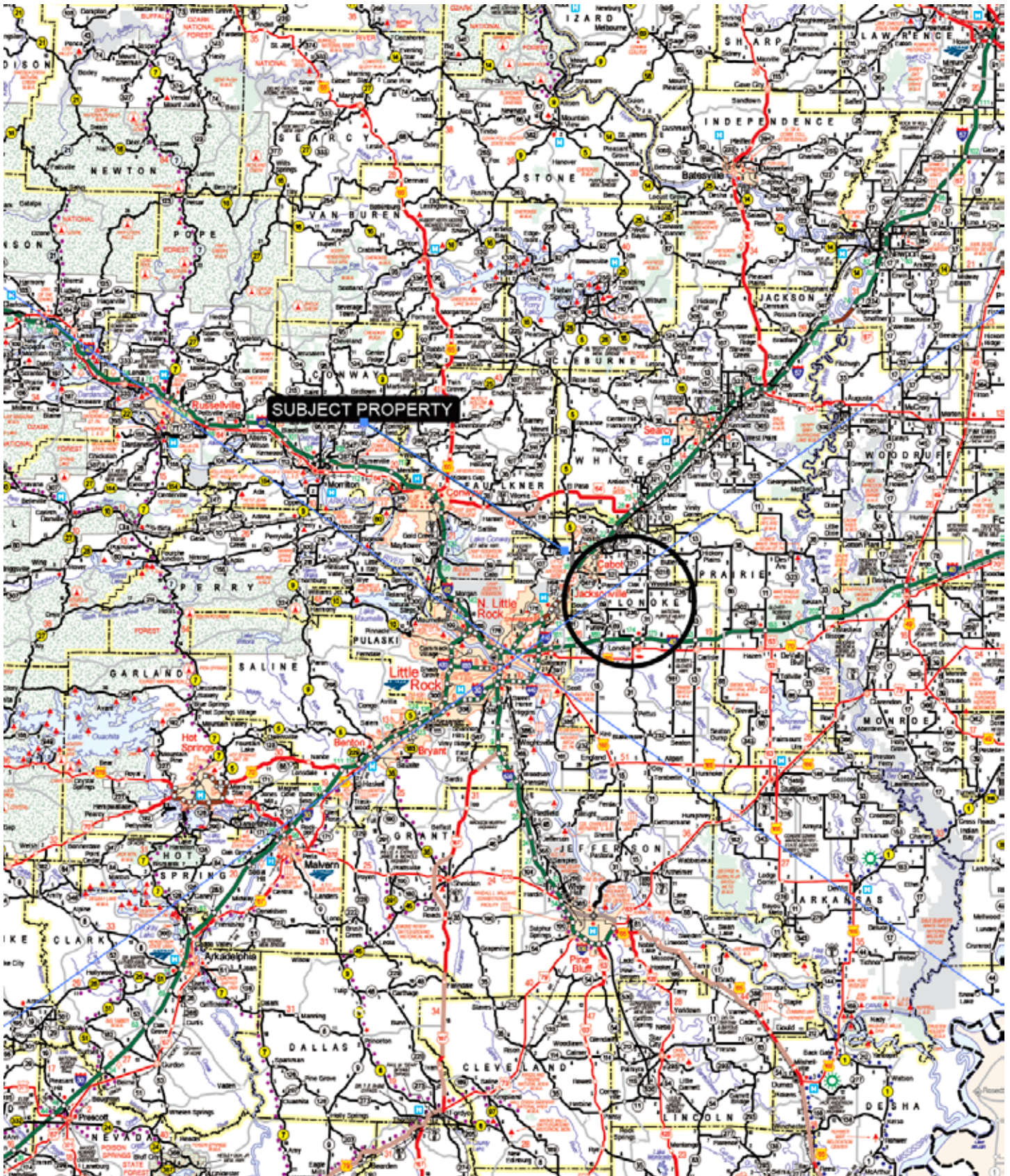

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

LONOKE WATTENSAW FARM

Located less than ten miles north of Lonoke off Arkansas State Highway 236, this 520± acre Lonoke County farm offers a well-established row crop operation with strong infrastructure and a modest recreational component.

The farm carries 462± planted cropland acres, per the Farm Service Agency office, with a history of rice, soybeans, and corn production. All of the cropland is irrigated and has been precision leveled with fall with the exception of the northern field which has been leveled to a zero grade. Irrigation is handled by a 14" diesel turbine re-lift, one 8" electric submersible well, and two 6" electric submersible wells, with water distributed across the farm through a system of risers and ditches. A 6.5± acre tailwater recovery pit captures field runoff and recycles it back into the irrigation system, reducing operating costs and supporting responsible water use. The level of improvement on the farm reflects the attention to detail that has gone into the farm to enhance the irrigation and agricultural production. All of the cropland is leased to Bernie Parker on a cash rent for the 2026 crop year.

Wattensaw Bayou runs along the northwestern edge of the farm offering 37± acres of recreational





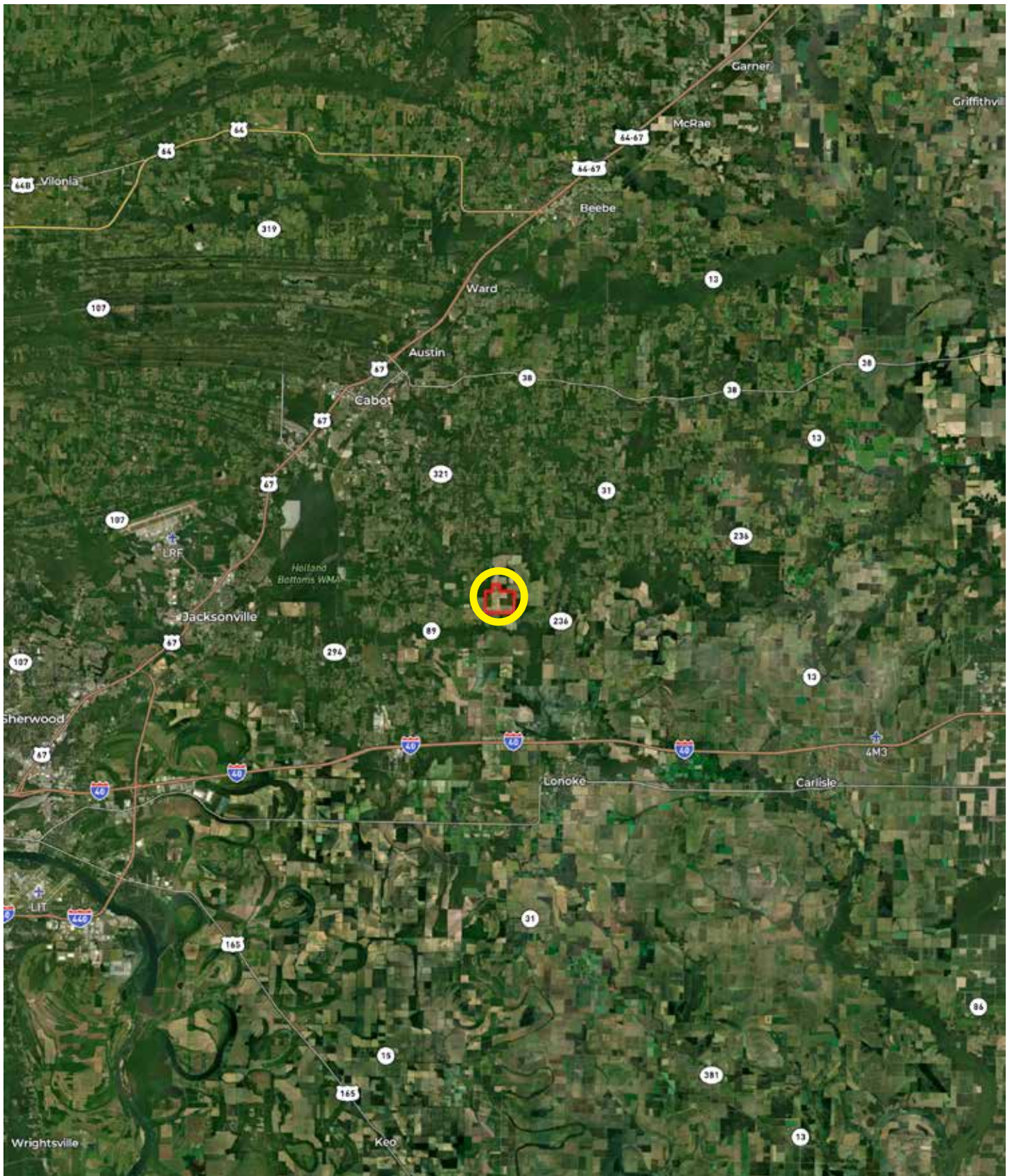
habitat. Mature willows anchor the northwest corner, the remaining pastureland is well-suited for food plots, and the bayou itself provides a natural draw for both deer and duck hunting.

The Lonoke Wattensaw Farm is accessible via a gravel road off Arkansas State Highway 236, putting it within easy reach of Little Rock, Lonoke, Jacksonville, and the surrounding area.

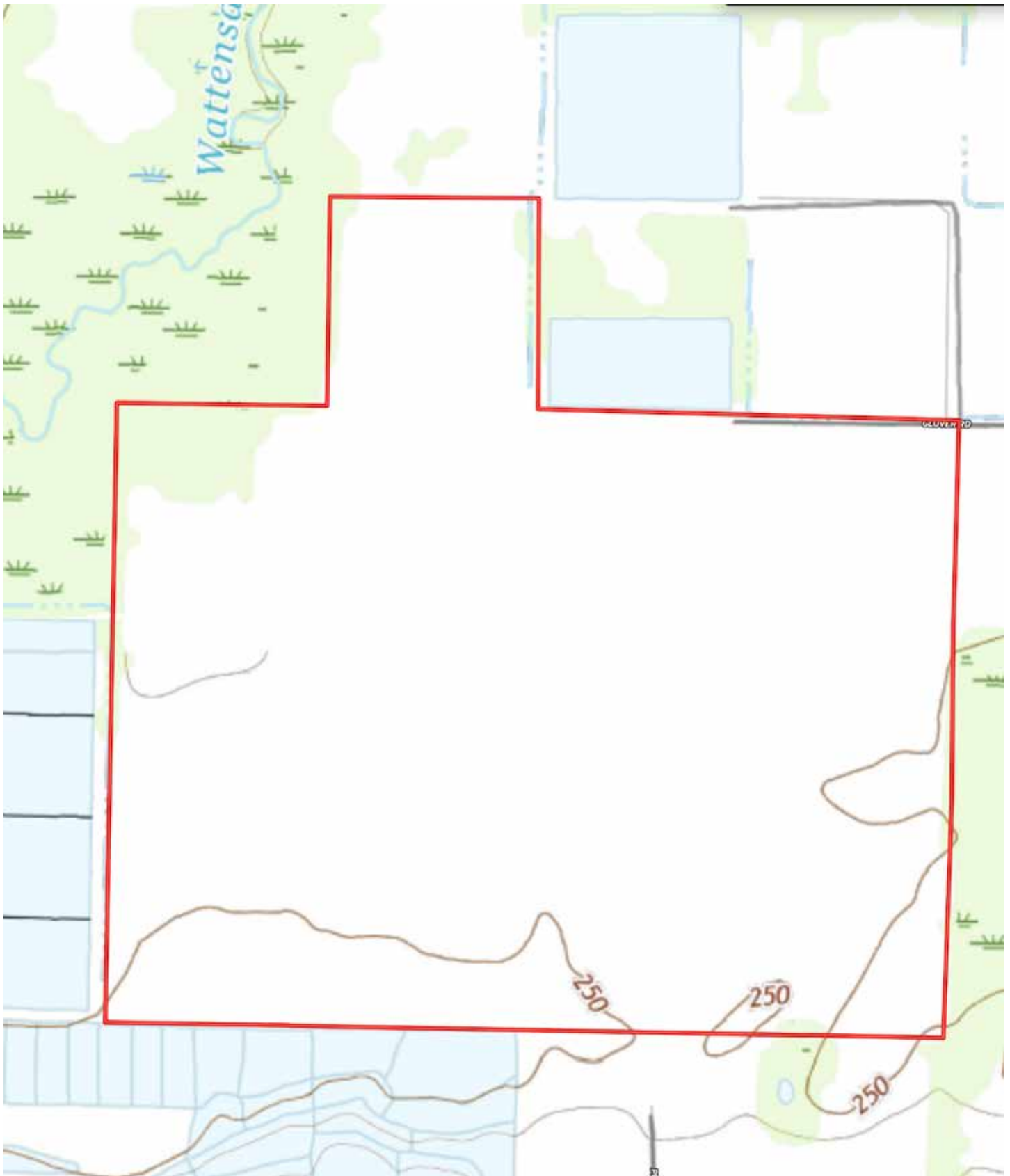




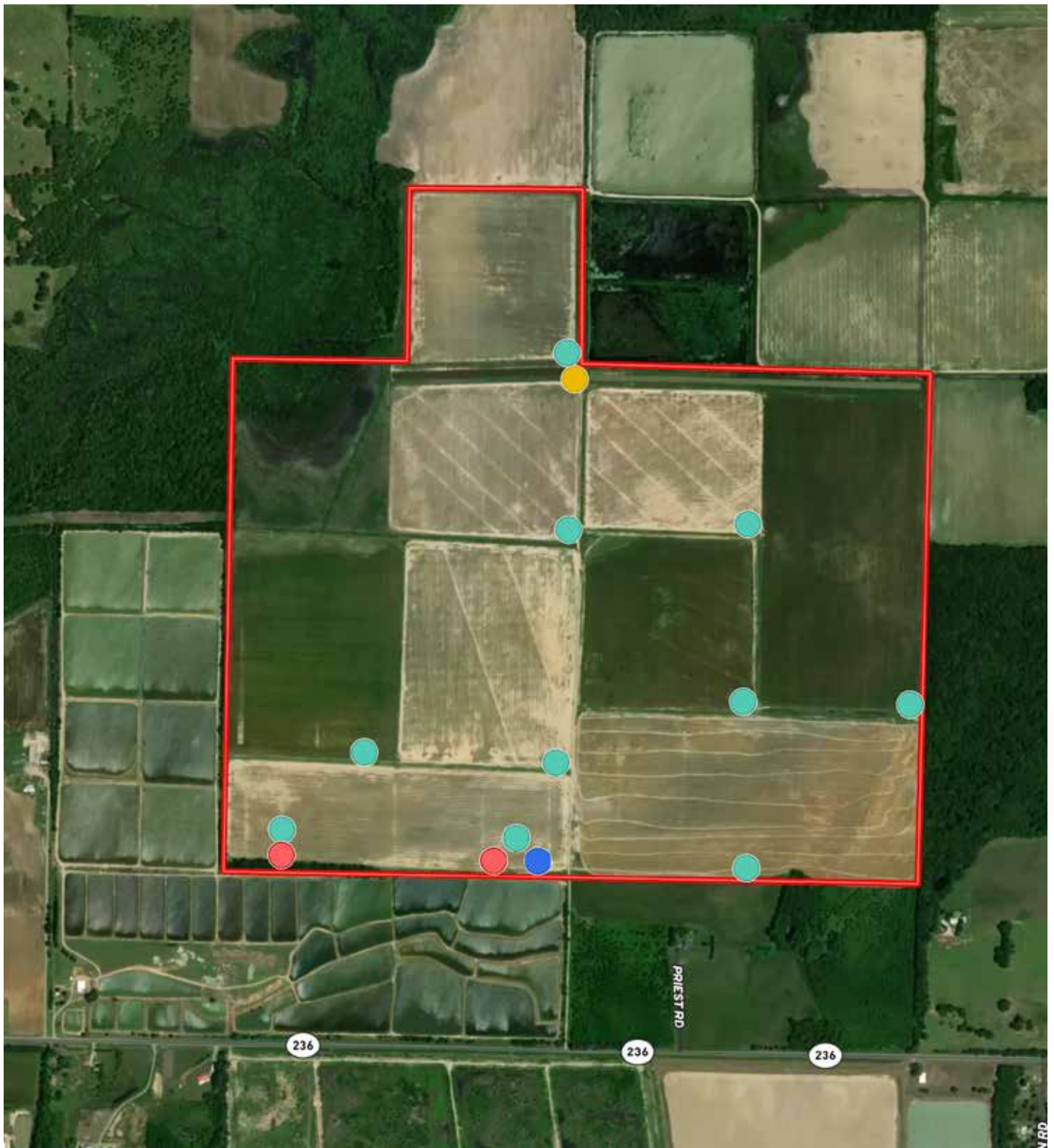




TOPOGRAPHY MAP

● 8" Electric Submersible ● 6" Electric Submersible ● 14" Diesel Turbine ● Riser

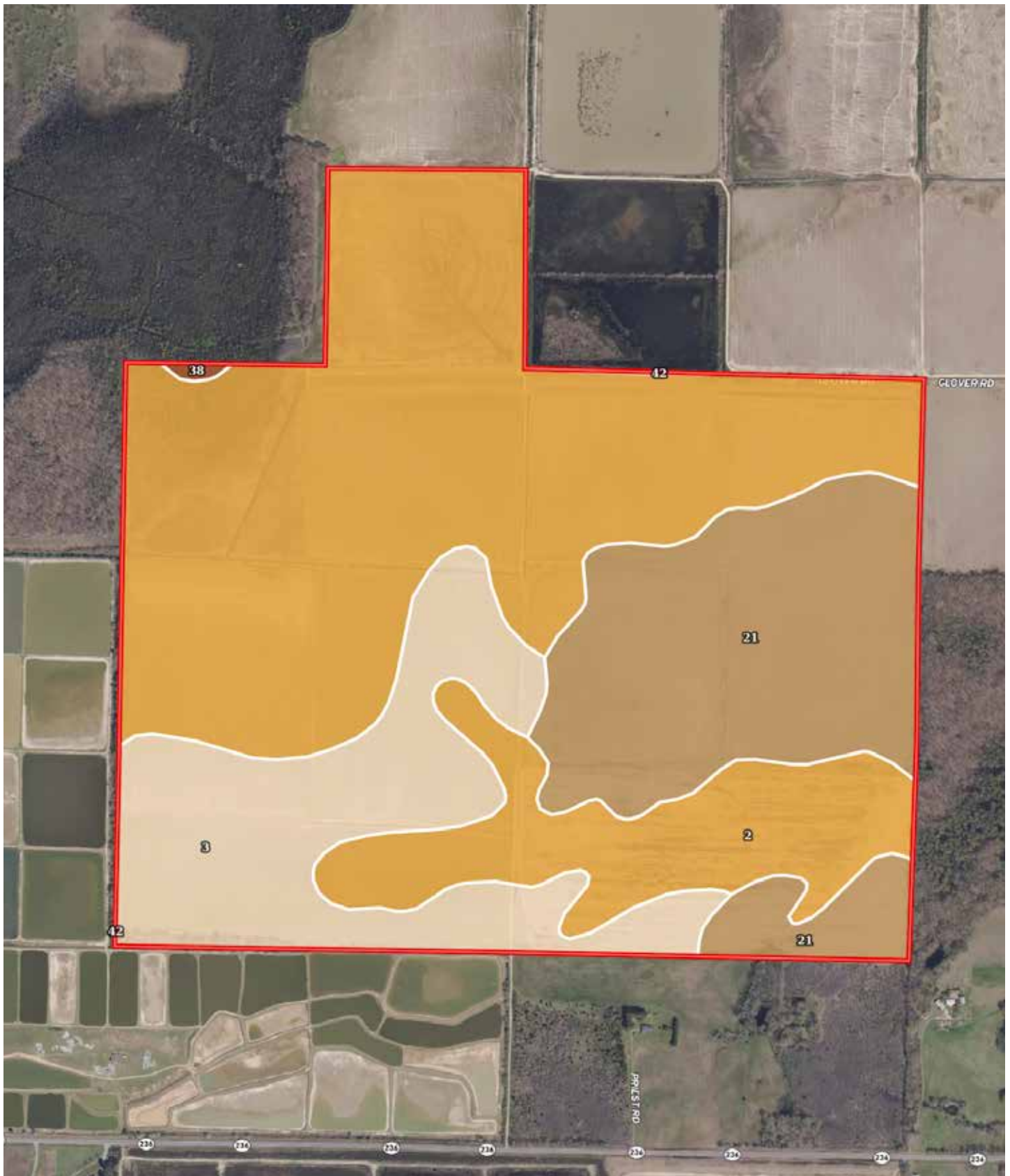

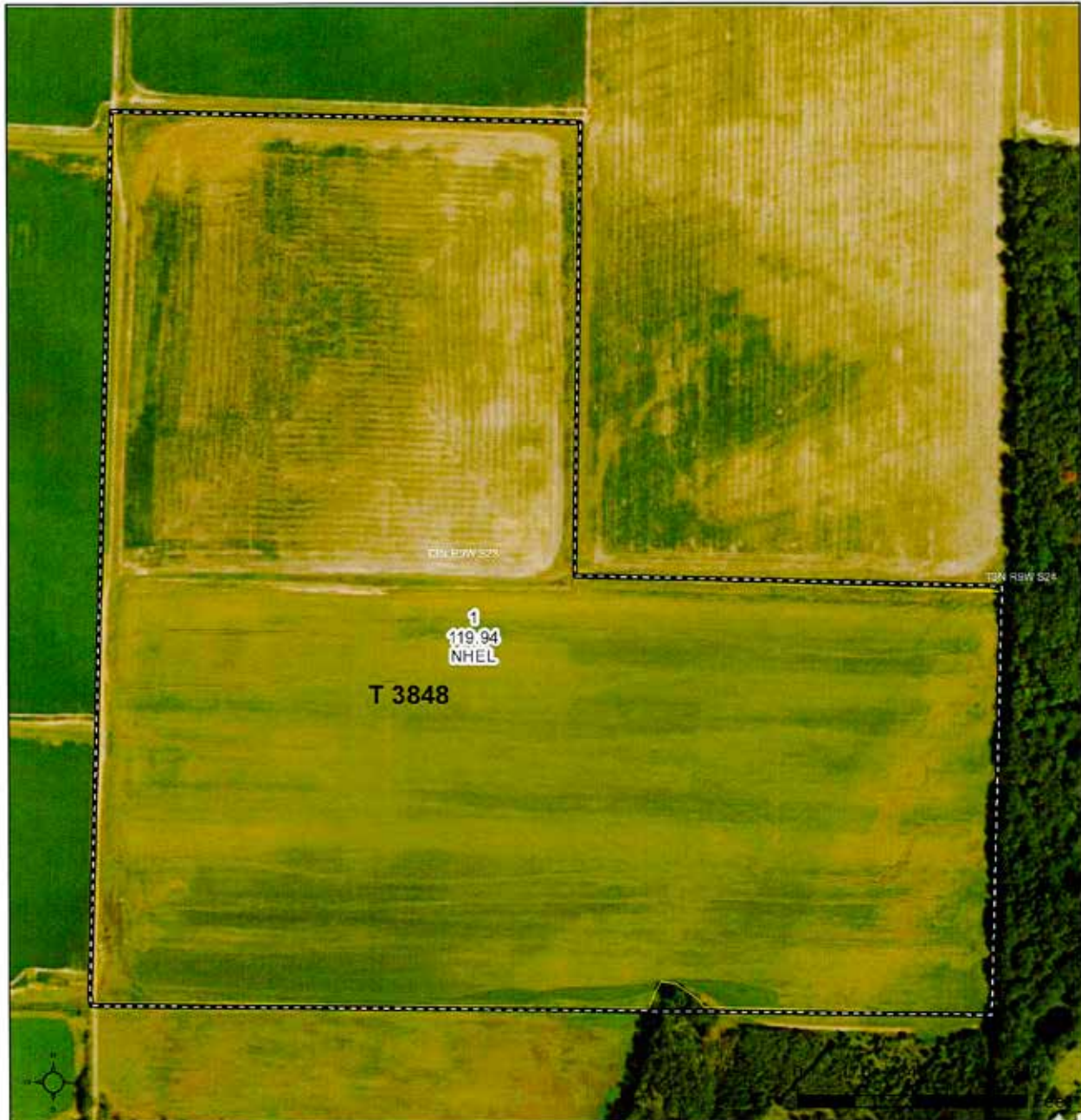
