





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# BAYOU BARTHOLOMEW



Bayou Bartholomew is proclaimed to be the longest bayou in the world. It begins just northwest of Pine Bluff, Arkansas and flows an estimated 375 miles to join the Ouachita River in Sterlington, Louisiana. This bayou has a one million acre watershed and is lined with old growth cypress and tupelo trees. The bayou is home to over 117 different species of fish and reported to be one of the most diverse streams in North America.

In the late 1700s, Spanish colonists used Bayou Bartholomew for transportation via flat-bottom barges as there were no good roads in the area at the time. In the early 1800s, steamboats were used on the Bayou for exporting cotton, timber, and other goods and was also used for importing supplies. Steam-boating continued on the Bayou during the Civil War, as it was used as a transportation route for troops and supplies. The bayou also has a history of being a major recreational site for locals.

The Bayou Bartholomew Alliance was created in 1995 by Curtis Merrell. The alliance, in conjunction with the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission, Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service, Envi-ronmental Protection Agency, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and Ducks Unlimited—and the public, is working to preserve Bayou Bartholomew's natural beauty.
